In September, the Council of the District of Columbia introduced **the Fossil Fuel Divestment Act of 2013** to take investments in the 200 publicly traded companies with the greatest fossil fuel reserves from its portfolios. By passing this bill, we will:

- **Protect residents from climate change**

Climate change is bringing to DC more extreme weather (like the Derecho, Superstorm Sandy and Typhoon Haiyan), higher food and energy prices from heat waves and the polar vortex, and poor air quality causing asthma.

- **Protect employees' pension and health funds**

Fossil fuel investments have had weak gains in the past five to ten years. Goldman Sachs, Morgan Stanley, HSBC and the World Bank recently released reports warning that the outlook for fossil fuel investments is bleak.
